FSC stands for Forest Stewardship Council – an internationally recognized forest certification organization that rigorously monitors forest operations to ensure sustainable lumber harvesting. FSC forest trees are individually selected for cutting and then replanted in a biodiverse manner, thus sustaining the health and longevity of our forests.

Why Use FSC Certified Wood?

- **Improved wood quality for better homes.** The kiln-dried Douglas Fir we use provides a more stable framework with less structural movement, as well as assuring better indoor air-quality than more conventional homes.

- **Protects the water supply.**

By reducing erosion, we protect our watersheds, help improve water quality, and provide fish habitat.

By using few pesticides and herbicides, wildlife, fish, non-harvested plants, and soil are protected.

Because few fertilizers are used, the soil and watersheds are protected from dangerous chemicals.
